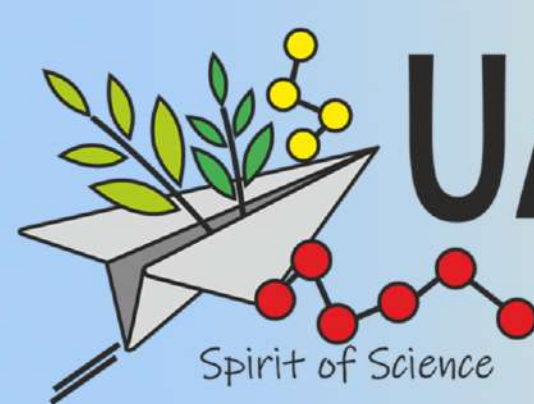

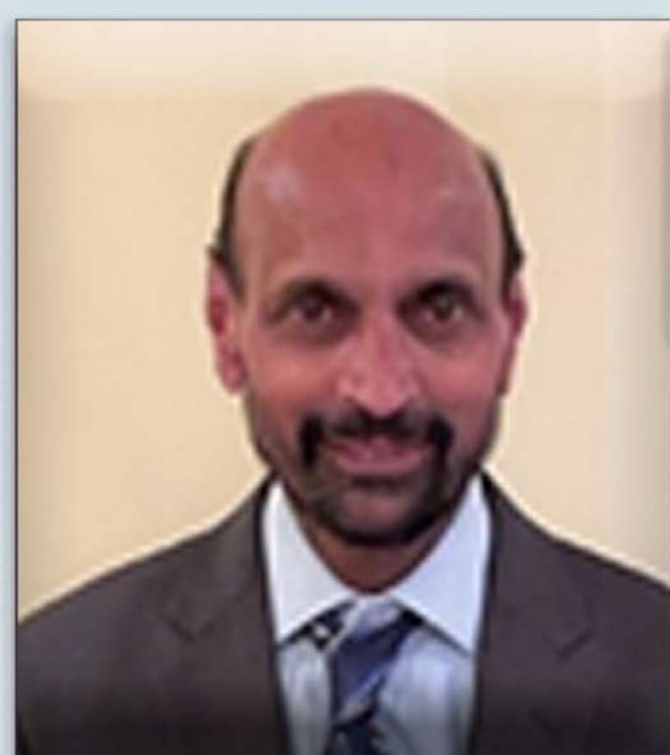

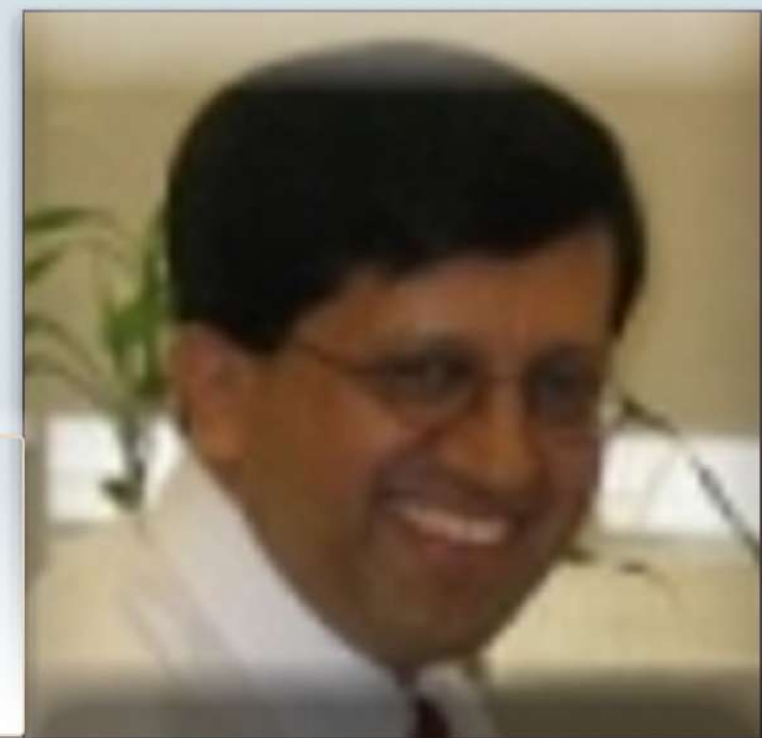

27 – 30 September 2021

The UASB-PG Science Week, started by the Directorate of Post Graduate (PG) studies during the year 2014, has become an annual event with a high scientific temperament. The event has become very popular and is being celebrated in the form of a science festival with a well-structured schedule and evaluation. The main goal of the event would be to inspire students and cultivate the habit of good research (both basic and translational), and communication skills to transfer the Agri-Science knowledge. During this Science Week 2021, all the outgoing Ph.D. scholars would present their research work through oral presentations. Over 900 students are participating in this year's meet and 104 Ph.D. scholars would be presenting their work.

This year's meet, designated as “UASB PG Science Week 2021: PG student’s Symposium” is scheduled for 27-30 September 2021. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the event is being organized in the form of a Webinar and all the graduating Ph.D. scholars will be presenting their work online through Zoom Video conferencing. The event will have three special sessions on “Science for Society”, “Excitement in Science”, and “Opportunities in Scientific Agriculture”. Although the symposium is planned for our PG students, it will be open for registration to anyone interested in the proceedings.

In this symposium, there will be one inaugural lecture and three different plenary talks by alumni of the UASB who have made significant overseas contributions in their respective fields. The plenary talks will be followed by the “Questions and Answers” session, which will be moderated by a senior faculty. There will be four different parallel sessions for students’ presentations as indicated below. The Doctoral students of UASB will present their research findings in the respective Divisional Groups, which will be evaluated by the subject specialists.

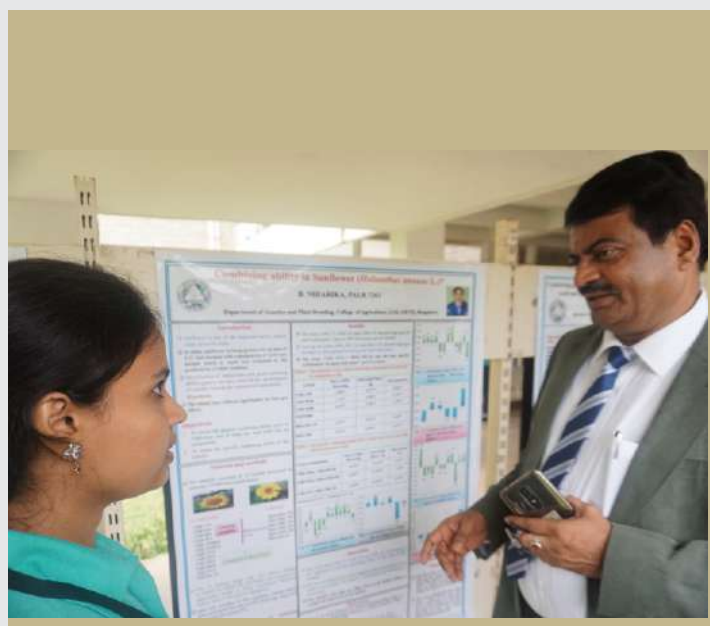
