



Students' Symposium 17-20 August, 2022



The UASB-PG Science Week, started by the Directorate of Post Graduate (PG) studies in 2014, has become an annual event with a high scientific temperament. The event has become very popular among Indian Agricultural Universities and is celebrated as a science festival with a well-structured schedule and evaluation of postgraduate research findings. The main goal of the event would be to inspire students and cultivate the habit of good research (both basic and translational) and communication skills to transfer the Agri-Science knowledge. During this PG Science Week 2022, all the outgoing PhD scholars will present their research work through oral presentations. Over 500 students are participating in this year's meeting, and 108 PhD scholars will present their work in the form of oral presentations.



This year's meet, designated as "PG Science Week 2022: Student's Symposium" is scheduled for 17-20 August, 2022. The event will have two special sessions, and invited speakers from abroad will address & inspire the participants on excitement in science and science for society. Although the symposium is planned for PG students of UASB, it will be open for registration to anyone interested in the proceedings. In this symposium, there will be an inaugural session on 17 August, 2022 and Dr. Krishnaswamy Vijay Raghavan, FRS, the former Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India, will be inaugurating the symposium.



As indicated below, there will be four parallel sessions for students presentations. The Doctoral students of UASB will make oral presentations, and master's students will present posters on their research findings in the respective Divisional Groups, which the subject specialists will evaluate.
