PM Kisan Samman Nidhi Programme



ICAR-KVK, MANDYA AND TUMAKURU-I, in collaboration with the Ministry of Agriculture, Government of India, organised the PM Kisan Samman Nidhi programme on 24th February, 2025. This occasion was pivotal for the agricultural community as it marked the distribution of the 19th instalment of the PM Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana to eligible beneficiaries. Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India addressed the farmers virtually, underscoring the significance of this initiative. Approximately ₹22,000 crores was disbursed directly into the bank accounts of 9.8 crores farmers across the country. In his remarks, the Prime Minister emphasized the government's steadfast dedication to the welfare of farmers, noting

that over the past six years, nearly ₹3.7 lakh crores has been transferred directly to farmers bank accounts through the PM-Kisan scheme. Additionally, the event witnessed, the celebration of the establishment of 10,000th Farmers Producers Organization in India, marking a significant achievement in the empowerment of farmers and the promotion of cooperative farming practices. The event held at V.C. Farm, Mandya was graced by the presence of Shri H.D. Kumaraswamy, Hon'ble Union Minister of Heavy Industries and Steel. The Minister in his address, emphasized the significance of central government initiatives in promoting and sustaining farmers' engagement in agriculture. He also underscored the crucial role of KVKs and developmental departments in assisting



farmers to access the benefits of these schemes. Furthermore, he encouraged the agricultural community to adopt climatesmart and resilient agricultural technologies to ensure sustainable farming.
