

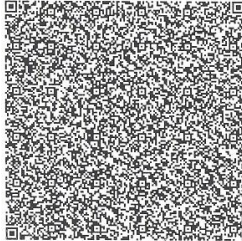

ARTICLE I: SCOPE OF THE COLLABORATION




GENERAL AREAS OF COOPERATION

1. Joint educational activities including training and other facilitation for students/candidates in the faculty of Life Sciences/Agriculture disciplines.
2. Develop and implement collaborative and/or independent research, or joint projects based on the policies and mutual interests of both institutions.
3. Collaboration for industrial applications of scalable technologies and mutual utilization of research facilities upon agreed terms and conditions.
4. Exchange scholarly information and library facilities including research papers, indices to theses, books and magazines on the relevant subjects.
5. Extend mutual invitations for attending scholarly and technical meeting as well as national and international conferences.
6. Neither institution is responsible for any financial support under this MOU. Individual scholar will make all arrangements by written agreement, which will be applicable to each particular situation.

ARTICLE II: GENERAL TERMS

- 1.1 This MOU is not intended to, and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents.
- 1.2 The activities of this MOU must be carried in accordance with appropriate Act and regulations existing in each both the institutions.
- 1.3 With regard to intellectual property, each institution will adhere to the existing intellectual property laws. Intellectual property developed during the visit of a faculty or student visitor will be governed by the rules of the host institution unless otherwise specified by an alternate agreement. In general, the two institutions shall jointly own jointly developed Intellectual property resulting from clearly defined collaborative projects. Whenever one institution receives any information from the partner under a clearly defined non-disclosure agreement, necessary steps will be taken to protect the Intellectual property received.
