GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ARTICLES TO MJAS

The Mysore Journal of Agricultural Sciences (MJAS) is a quarterly journal published by the University of Agricultural Sciences, Bangalore comprising original 'Scientific Review Articles' and 'Research Articles' in the field of Agriculture and Allied Sciences including Animal Science, Social Science and Home Science. Following are the guidelines to authors for submission of articles to MJAS

- Authors must submit the duly signed declaration stating that the Scientific Review Article / Research Article has neither been published nor sent for publication in any other Journal.
- 2) Once a paper is accepted for publication, it should not be published elsewhere either in the same or abridged form or in any other language, without the permission of the Editor. Further, once the data is published in MJAS, the same/part of the data should not be duplicated again in MJAS and it is the sole responsibility of the author(s). Such of the authors found guilty would be banned from submission of articles to MJAS for a period of two years including the co-authors. The data of five years old experiment or trial will not be accepted.
- 3) Preferably only one article per author (first author) would be considered for publication in a single issue. If multiple articles are submitted as a first author at a time, the same will be considered for publication in the upcoming issues if found acceptable.
- 4) The manuscript of the Research Article must contain sufficient data with at least 4-5 Tables/figures/plates/graphs to be published as full-length paper, otherwise the same will not be considered. The abstract must be meaningfully briefed in less than 300 words. Citing at least two recent relevant references from earlier issues of MJAS is mandatory.
- 5) While submitting the Scientific Review Article, the authors must take care that it is a critical account of not just summarizing what has been published on a topic by accredited researchers but it discusses critically, identifies methodological problems and must point out research gaps. The paper must contain new scientific insights, highlight gaps, conflicting results and under-examined areas of research. The review paper submitted must generate an understanding of the topic for the readers by discussing the findings presented in recent research papers.

- 6) Mentioning e-mail ID and cell phone number along with the affiliation in the manuscript is a must for the first and corresponding author. If it is a student research, it should be routed through proper channel mentioning the details of the chairman of the advisory committee.
- 7) The illustrations and text-figures should be clear and capable of reproduction in print. The soft copy of the photos/ figures should be separately submitted in JPEG format only. Legends to figures and photos should be typed in the foot of the figure/ photo.
- 8) Invariably all the authors of the 'Review Article' and 'Research Paper' should be the subscribers {Annual membership (Rs. 400/- / Life membership (Rs.3000/-)} of the Journal and should also pay a processing fee of Rs. 100/- per article. Subscription amount either Annual or Life may be deposited in the Bank in the favour of Editor, S/B Account No. 0425101030928, Canara Bank, GKVK Branch, Bengaluru-560065. - 9) The soft copy of the Review Article and Research Paper in MJAS format must only be submitted through on-line only using the link https://e-krishiuasb.karnataka.gov.in/MJAS/Home.aspx
